





LOOK WHO'S BACK: THE SPINY SEAHORSE

n endangered species of seahorse, native to the UK, has been spotted in British waters for the first time in more than two years. Marine conservationists spotted 16 spiny seahorses near Studland Bay in Dorset. This is the highest number the scientists have seen in a single dive, since they began studying the area in 2008. Seahorses have been able to return to their habitat, thanks to the lockdown that saw fewer people and boats in the area.

Seahorses, which live in long seagrass, are often damaged by boats and other human activity The UK's two native seahorse species- the spiny and the short-snouted seahorse, were granted protected status in 2008, under the Wildlife & Countryside Act. In 2017, as many as six seahorses were spotted in the River Thames




